Guide Dogs shopping list

Reflective harness sleeve: £3.56

A fluorescent harness sleeve that keeps our dogs safe when walking in the dark.

Chrome dog bell: £4.20

The bell helps guide dog owners keep track of their dog when they're off the leash.

Puppy lead: £6.91

Guide dog puppies have a special yellow and blue webbing lead.

Brown buckle collar: £7.50

An important piece of kit for any guide dog.

Harness handle: £15.50

One of the most important bits of kit – it's the medium through which the guide dog owner feels where their dog is headed.

Training harness: £26.50

Every guide dog begins training with a brown harness before moving up to the smart white qualification harness.

Doggy paddle: £40.00

A hydrotherapy pool session for a guide dog with mobility problems.



Harness, handle and lead: £54.50

The iconic symbol of a working guide dog, and an essential piece of kit for guiding safely.



Ten traffic cones: £90

An obstacle course at Guide Dog Training School that will prepare trainee guide dogs and their future owners for real world challenges.



Off to school kit: £95

A puppy works with a volunteer puppy walker learning basic commands and getting used to the situations they'll encounter as adult guide dogs. The kit provides a volunteer with the basic equipment including leads, car harness, training jacket.



Whelping kit: £200

The essential equipment for a successful delivery – including everything from bedding to a heat lamp. It's the perfect welcome into the world for a loveable litter.
